Vulture Captive Breeding Programmes

As one of the few organisations in Africa focused exclusively on protecting and rehabilitating vultures, VulPro operates throughout Southern Africa, and together with the Shamwari Foundation, VulPro@SHAMWARI operates at the Eastern Cape rehabilitation centre.



Threats Faced by African Vultures:

- Poisoned Carcasses Linked to Poaching
- Power Line and Wind Energy Turbine Collisions
- Reduction in Nesting and Foraging Habitats
- Targeted Killings for Local Cultural Practices

- Rescue, Rehabilitation, and Release
- Captive Breeding Programmes
- Research and Monitoring
- Community and Conservation Partnerships
- Education and Advocacy
